Dear Families,

During the summer, your child is required to read ten books from the summer reading list. Feel free to supplement the reading list. Reading daily will strengthen fluency and comprehension. It is wonderful and beneficial for your child to read orally and to be read to.

I would like your child to choose a favorite character from one of the books he/she reads, and create a puppet. This can be done by using a sock, a stick and construction paper, a paper bag, felt, etc. During the first week of school, the children will present their puppets to the class. They will name the title of the book, who the character is and why it is his/her favorite character.

In addition to reading, I would like you to review basic addition and subtraction facts with your child. This can be done in a relaxed atmosphere such as sitting under a tree or riding in the car. You can also visit a math website...www.learninggamesforkids.com.

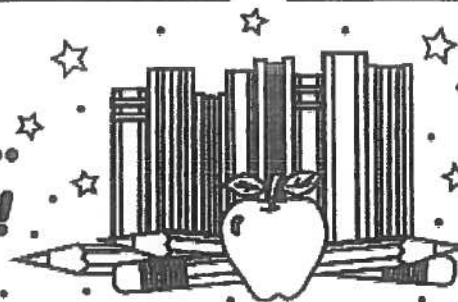
