In the fall, I will give you all the details, but in order for you to succeed you will need to complete your summer reading sheets well (complete sentences, correct capitalization, punctuation, and each paragraph should be at least five sentences, but no more than eight).

Along with these three outlines, you will keep record of your reading in the attached log. In fifth grade it is a requirement that you read 100 minutes a week which is equal to 20 minutes for five days per week.

It is also imperative that you know all your multiplication and division facts. I have attached a math log which you will also need to fill out. In 5th grade you are required to fill out a math log every night for a total of 50 minutes a week or ten minutes a day for five days. If you complete this there will be an ultimate prize !
