Thank you for your interest in our five full-day, 4 year-old Blessed Sacrament Preschool Program. Enrollment is open to children who will be four years old by September 1, 2018.

Enclosed you will find the necessary materials for registration. Once you decide that Blessed Sacrament School is the right place for your child, we will need a few other things, along with the registration form. Please provide a copy of your child's most recent immunization records and physical examination, birth certificate and baptismal certificate if he or she has been baptized. Included in this packet is a Release of Records form if your child has already been enrolled in a school. Please sign the form and return it with your registration form. It is expected that you will advise us of any learning or behavioral problems your child may have.

The tuition for the 4 year-old preschool for the 2018-2019 school year is \$5,100.00 if registered by July 1st and \$5,200.00 after July 1st. The program begins at 8:15AM and ends at 2:30PM each day. At time of registration, you will be required to pay a \$200.00 registration fee, which will be deducted from your tuition due. **Students registering after August 1st must pay the full first month's tuition, or present a current letter of eligibility from the DHS Childcare Assistance program, before a spot can be reserved in the class.** All students must create a FACTS tuition account. Families have the option of paying monthly, bi-annually, or annually. Also attached are two copies of the Preschool Guidelines. Please read the guidelines and return a signed copy to the office at time of registration. The other copy is for your records.

In addition, each family is required to sell \$100.00 worth of Ten Month Club tickets. If you choose not to sell the tickets, you must pay the \$100.00 yourself.
