Dear Families:

Thank you for your interest in Blessed Sacrament School. Our registration period for new students will begin on **Thursday, January 26th**. Enrollment is open to children in preschool through grade 7. We do not usually accept new students in our eighth grade.

Enclosed you will find the necessary materials for registration. We also ask that your child spend some or all of a day with us. Your child can visit the class he or she will be joining next year and take part in a simple assessment by our teachers. Come and see for yourself why Blessed Sacrament School is a leader in Catholic School education.

Once you decide that Blessed Sacrament School is the right place for your child, we will need a few other things, along with the registration form. Please provide a copy of your child's most recent immunization records and physical examination, birth certificate and baptismal certificate if he or she has been baptized. We also will need a copy of your child's most recent report card. Also, it is expected that you will advise us of any learning or behavioral problems your child may have. Included in this packet is a form for release of your child's records. Please sign the form and return it with the registration form.

The tuition for the 2012-2013 school year is \$3,800.00 per child. Please read carefully the registration guidelines and return a signed copy, along with the \$380.00 first payment, plus a one-time \$55.00 registration fee for a total of \$435.00 to the school. Your check should be made payable to **Blessed Sacrament School**. Anyone wishing to pay the tuition in full by March 1st will receive a \$100.00 credit.

In addition, each family is required to sell \$100 worth of Ten Week Club tickets. If you choose not to sell the tickets, you must pay the \$100 yourself.
